

English People in Majority in County

Residents of British Origins Combined Account for 20,428 out of 21,337 Total

More than 55 per cent of the population of Charlotte County is of English origins, with Irish and Scotch taking second and third places and the British races combined accounting for 20,428 of the 21,337 people in the municipality. These statistics are contained in the bulletin of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on racial origins, for which information was collected in the census of 1931.
